Franklin ss: To the constables of the Town of Bernardston in the county of Franklin:

Greetings:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said town qualified to vote in elections and town affairs to meet at the Bernardston Town Hall on Monday the first (1st) day of May next, at eleven o'clock in the morning (11:00am) then and there to bring in their votes on one ballot for the following offices:

- One (1) Assessor for three (3) years; One (1) member of the Board of Health for there (3) years;
- One (1) Constable for three (3) years; Four (4) Cushman Library Trustees each for three (3) years;
- One (1) Town Moderator for three (3) years; Four (4) Powers Institute Trustees each for three (3) years;
- One (1) Powers Institute Trustee for one (1) year;

Three (3) members of the Recreation Commission each for three (3) years; One (1) Selectman for three (3) years; and

Question One (1) Shall the Town of Bernardston be allowed to exempt from the provisions of proposition two and one-half, so-called, the amounts required to pay for the bond issued in order to replace the Turners Falls Road Bridge inclusive of engineering design, environmental permitting and construction costs?

You are hereby directed to serve this warrant by posting up certified copies thereof at least 7 (seven) days before the time of holding said meeting at the 5 (five) places within the town listed below:

- Bernardston Town Hall, 38 Church Street / Bernardston Post Office, 9 Center Street
- Country Corner Store, 44 Church Street / 7 South Street Bakery, 7 South Street
- Bernardston Senior Center, 20 Church Street

Hereof fail not and make due return of this notice with your doing thereon to the Town Clerk at the time and place of said meeting aforesaid.
